## INVITATION TO SUBMIT EXPRESSION OF INTEREST TO UNDERGO RECOGNITION OF PRIOR LEARNING (RPL)

The Mauritius Qualifications Authority (MQA) is inviting applications for RPL in the under-mentioned sectors of the economy.

RPL enables a person, who has acquired over the years skills and competencies outside the formal education and training system, to obtain a duly recognised qualification.

Thus, potential candidates having worked for at least **three years** in their respective sectors as listed below are requested to express their interest by completing the application form to undergo RPL against National Qualifications in the following fields:

1	Tourism and Hospitality	Food Production   Housekeeping   Restaurant and Bar Services
2	Building and Construction	Masonry   Carpentry
3	Mechanical and Electrical Engineering	Plumbing   Welding   Electrical Installation Works

The duly filled application form together with a copy of National Identity Card and evidence of at least three years working experience in the aforesaid fields should be submitted to the MQA by **28 April 2017**. Potential candidates will be subject to a screening exercise. Only those who upon satisfying the eligibility criteria for RPL will then be called to effect payment of processing fee of Rs 2,000/- [level 2] or Rs 2,500/- [level 3], as applicable.

Note: An assessment fee of Rs 4,310/- will also be applicable at the time of submission of portfolio during the course of the RPL process.
