## COMMUNIQUE

### Implementation of Quality Assurance Framework for the TVET Sector in Mauritius

The Mauritius Qualifications Authority (MQA) has developed a Quality Assurance Framework (QAF) for the TVET sector in line with international norms with a view to enhance quality in training in Mauritius.

The QAF will act as an instrument for registered training institutions to enhance their quality assurance processes benchmarked against international norms in order to further promote quality training in Mauritius. It consists of the principles, methodologies, actions, measures and instruments through which quality in TVET is assured, at systems and at providers level.

The Quality Assurance Framework is intended to replace the Quality Assurance Standards as from 01 July 2018 and will be applicable to all new applications in the first instance. All those currently registered will be given a one (1) year moratorium period and shall abide to the quality principles of the QAF at latest by 01 July 2019.
